a. WD/D/20/000193 2 Norburton, Burton Bradstock-Proposed single storey front extension, single storey rear extension and conversion of roof space to habitable use to include a front and rear dormer, with conversion of roof to gable end, with new gable end windows.

A report objecting to the application had been circulated based on the previous PC comments to No 1 Norburton. Cllrs gave their views on the application, further objections were noted that the development is out of keeping with the area, the loss of mixed housing types for the village with bungalows no longer being built also that this development is in the conservation area. Some Cllrs felt the application was an improvement on the current housing stock, several Cllrs commented that they had no objections. Following no other comments, the PC moved to a proposal and vote.

GRM proposed the paper objecting to the application that was circulated and seconded by DD, Cllrs then voted on this, 4 Cllrs For and 5 Cllrs Against therefore the proposal to object was not resolved. The PC will now not raise any objections but will put forward the following comment, Burton Bradstock Parish Council can find no material planning considerations affected by this application, therefore the PC do not raise any objections.

b. WD/D/20/000863 SEVEN DWARFS, 105 SOUTHOVER, BURTON BRADSTOCK-Carry out internal and external alterations

This application was only received on 24th April, Cllrs had looked at the proposal online and no objections were recorded by the PC
