Bollards Outside the Toilet Block

We have inspected the area outside the toilets. We think that access wide enough for buggies to the “narrowed” road crossing just to the east of the toilets should be maintained. However the bollards previously installed have suffered considerable damage, which we believe would be repeated if repaired/ replaced by similar items. We think that the installation of sleepers with their narrowest dimension horizontal, fixed to the concrete surface by bolts, and with reflectors to warn vehicles and pedestrians would probably provide the lasting clear access looked for.

Similarly sleepers fixed on the parking area at right angles to the road on the western side of the toilets could be used to delineate the area that needs to be kept clear for access to the playing field. We think that this should be accompanied by a sign on a post saying “No Parking Access Required at All Times” or similar.

If the Council agrees we shall pursue a specification and quotes for a future meeting.
