# 5. GUEST SPEAKER - Eimear Coyle, Litter Free Dorset - campaigning to reduce litter and improve water quality in Dorset

Eimear Coyle, the Project Officer for Litter Free Dorset gave an informative talk about the organisation, what they do and current litter free campaigns.

# 6. OPEN DISCUSSION - opportunity for parishioners to have their say, raise questions and provide ideas relating to the parish of Burton Bradstock

### 1) Speed Limit

- speed of vehicles in the village is a major issue;
- noise and speed of motorbikes also a major issue;
- suggestion of a pedestrian crossing at the school;
- concerns regarding pedestrian safety when walking along road/pavement pedestrians being hit by car mirrors;
- speed of vehicles along Beach Road is a major concern Cllr Roberts looking at.
- Parish Council would like a SID (Speed Indicator Device) but recent traffic survey suggests speeds through the village not excessive and therefore do not meet the SID criteria.
- need to reduce the speed of vehicles coming into the village;
- suggestion of need for road signage although difficult due to AONB designation;
- suggestion of moving golf club footpath to the perimeter Cllr Roberts agreed to speak to the Dorset Council Green Spaces team.
- Cllr Ward suggested that a Parish Council Working Group be set up of Councillors and residents with a set of priorities to enable a coordinated and focused way forward to be progressed.

### 2) Broadband

- Cllr Mealing agreed to contact Jurassic Fibre for an update on broadband rollout in Burton Bradstock.

# 3) Bins

- suggestion that the bin at Larkfield needs to be moved next to the Corncrake field gate. Clerk to look at.

# 4) Corncrake

- the management of Corncrake was raised. The area is used as a dog walking field making the grass unusable for straw. The grass currently needs cutting - Clerk to look at. The management plan for Corncrake also needs to be reviewed as the current plan is ineffective.
