

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS 27 & 12, BURTON BRADSTOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. **All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along footpath 27, from grid reference SY 490 895 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 490 895 (point B on the map below), a distance of approximately 70 metres. Also, from grid reference SY 490 894 (point C on the map below), to grid reference SY 490 895 (point D on the map below), a distance of approximately 35 metres.** The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 24 July 2023 for a period of 5 weeks but it will remain in force for 26 weeks and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This Order is required to allow for the replacement of the highways footbridge.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE;

On this occasion there is no alternative route.

W7/12 and the southern section of W7/27, will remain open on a slightly diverted alignment around the works area.
